I am the most experienced Chartered Surveyor in the country providing property and business management advice to the garden centre and horticultural industry throughout the United Kingdom for over 30 years.

When one considers the value of both large garden centres and horticultural nurseries, there are in general, relatively few purchasers for any one specific opportunity. Therefore, detailed knowledge of the industry is important in order to understand who could be interested because in certain parts of the country some garden centres will be very difficult, if not impossible, to sell except at highly reduced values just due to lack of demand. The majority of valuers, no matter from which company, will just not have this knowledge and experience.

I commenced working in property in 1976 and in the garden centre and horticultural industry in 1986 forming Quinton Edwards in 1989.

I am an Associate Member of the Horticultural Trades Association and Garden Centre Association and have attended all the Garden Centre Association Conferences since 1990.

We currently sponsor the Garden Retail of the Year Awards, Grower of the Year Awards, British Association of Landscape Industry Awards plus the FARMA Annual Awards and the Garden Centre Association Annual Dinner.
