RESEARCH

- I have carried out a research project, entitled 'Free Tissue transfer of a transduced flap as a vehicle for gene and virus therapy of cancer.'
- Principal researcher: I carried out all the surgical and lab-based procedures in this project. I used the free Superficial Inferior Epigastric Artery flaps in rat models and transduced them with therapeutic strategies while disconnected from their blood supply.
- A total of 200 free flaps (200 artery and 200 vein microanastomoses in a rat animal model). Following the period of transduction, the flaps were reconnected at the level of the femoral artery and vein and then monitored over the experimental period.
- I set up the animal model, characterised the healing at the flap-bed interface and carried out therapy within the model to assess suicide gene therapy.
- I showed a significant difference in tumour growth kinetics following this form of therapy with a significant delay in tumour growth between the control and therapeutic cohorts. One animal showed complete remission and no tumour growth within the experimental time period.
- I was awarded a research fellowship by the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and
- Ireland for the first year of my work. I was awarded the ASiT medal for my oral presentation at ASiT 2012 conference.
- This work was carried out at the Institute of Cancer Research, Fulham Rd, London and was completed in August 2010 (Aug 2007 -2010).
