INTRODUCTION

Dr. Steinman has provided expert witness services in cases related to Mohs surgery, dermatologic surgery, and cosmetic dermatology since 2000. He has been retained to review over 73 cases, with 66% for the plaintiff and 34% for the defense. He has participated in 13 depositions and 9 court testimonies.

He retired from full-time clinical practice in 2022 and continues to teach dermatology surgery to residents at Campbell University.

In 2024, Dr. Steinman received the American Academy of Dermatology Presidential Citation for dedication as an educator of excellence of Mohs surgery.

Also in 2024, he was appointed an Honorary Lifetime Fellow with Distinction by the American Society for Mohs Surgery.

He is a board-certified dermatologist, fellowship-trained Mohs surgeon, and cosmetic dermatologist with more than 35 years of clinical experience. He has expertise in managing adverse events associated with Mohs surgery, dermatologic surgery, chemical peels, dermal fillers, and botulinum toxin injections.

He has co-authored two textbooks on Mohs surgery, published 60 articles on dermatology and dermatologic surgery, and given over 220 presentations on Mohs surgery, dermatologic surgery, and dermatology.
